



Dear Winston Families,

Like you, we are keeping a close eye on the daily updates and recommendations regarding the coronavirus (COVID-19). Winston School receives routine guidance and updates from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), the World Health Organization (WHO), the National Association of Independent Schools (NAIS), and the New Jersey Association of Independent Schools (NJ AIS). The health and safety of our community members are always our number one priority and we continue to adapt and adopt measures to support the health and wellness of our community.

Most notably, we caution all families that if you are planning international travel, you risk being separated from campus for a period of quarantine upon your return. If you visit a country that is designated with a CDC Warning Level, your child will be required to stay home and away from fellow students for 14 days after your return. We are following **the current standard quarantine period recommended by the CDC and an important public health safety precaution**. Even if there is no current occurrence of COVID-19 for your travel destinations, we recommend that you remain updated and informed in order to consider the risks related to your travel and the consequences associated with your return.

As part of our School's emergency preparedness protocols, and in the event of a required closing of campus for any duration, we will provide all Winston families with detailed information about our remote learning programs. We will work closely with your children so that they will bring home the materials necessary for our planned on-line programs.
